



PREPARATION GUIDE

To ensure a comfortable and enjoyable stay at camp, carefully read the following information and use the checklist while packing.

- 🐾 **Adults/Legal Guardians MUST complete the online [AGREEMENTS FORM](#). Children that DO NOT have a completed AGREEMENTS FORM will not be allowed to participate.**
- 🐾 **Registration begins at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday** and takes about an hour. Please do not arrive more than 30 minutes earlier, as there will be no staff available to greet and assist you.
- 🐾 **Pick-up is at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday.** For safety and security reasons, all people picking up campers must be listed on the camper's registration profile as a parent, legal guardian or approved alternative **and show original, valid, government-issued photo ID.**
- 🐾 Laundry is only done on the weekends so be sure to have enough clean clothing for a one-week period.
- 🐾 We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. To prevent mixing up or losing belongings, use labels, or label all clothes and equipment with permanent marker. Write down a list of all your child's stuff.
- 🐾 Please call (905) 983-8217 for camp information or camper inquiries. Messages are picked-up and returned everyday between 7:30pm – 8:00pm. **Do not call the Jungle Cat World office.** It would be appreciated if parents do not call to inquire about the status of their children. If you don't hear from us, then everything is fine! It is made clear to the campers during orientation that they can call home if necessary.

First and foremost, it's important that campers bring a sense of adventure, positive attitude and a willingness to learn and share!

PREPARATION GUIDE

To ensure a comfortable and enjoyable stay at camp, carefully read the following information and use the checklist while packing.

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

- Camera for wildlife photography
- Stuff for the Talent Show, such as a costume, musical instrument, etc.

RECOMMENDATION OF THINGS NOT TO BRING:

- ▶ Safari Zoo Camp is informal. There is no need for fancy dress clothes.
- ▶ We **strongly** discourage jewellery. If earrings must be worn, do not wear anything that dangles.
- ▶ Hair styling appliances, such as curling irons, flat irons, hair dryers, etc.
- ▶ Money. Campers are not allowed to visit the gift shops during their stay at camp.

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

The following items are prohibited to ensure the safety and well-being of the campers and the animals. The possession of any of these items will result in immediate expulsion from the program with no refund. Campers may voluntarily hand over any of the below items at the beginning of the session without being penalized. Thank you for your co-operation.

- ▶ Explosives and/or flammable substances such as matches, lighters, fireworks, etc.
- ▶ Weapons, including pocket-knives.
- ▶ Cigarettes, marijuana, alcohol and/or illegal drugs.
- ▶ Prescription and/or non-prescription medication not listed on the camper's registration profile.
- ▶ Electronic music devices and gaming consoles, such as iPods, Nintendo Switch, etc.
- ▶ Food or snacks (some campers have potentially fatal food allergies).
- ▶ Pets.
- ▶ Smartphones or other electronic communication devices.
